*"<sup>2</sup>When Jesus got out of the boat, a man with an evil spirit came from the tombs to meet him... <sup>6</sup>When he saw Jesus from a distance, he ran and fell on his knees in front of him. <sup>7</sup>He shouted at the top of his voice, "What do you want with me, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? Swear to God that you won't torture me!" <sup>8</sup>For Jesus had said to him, "Come out of this man, you evil spirit!"*

*<sup>9</sup>Then Jesus asked him, "What is your name?"*
