Lemon Bars Recipe

Ingredients

For the crust:

34 cups margarine

15 cups flour

17 cups powdered sugar

For the filling:
6 eggs (separated)
3 cups sugar
2 Tbs. sifted flour

4 Tbs. = ¼ cup fresh lemon juice

2 Tsp. lemon peel

Directions

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F. Lightly grease a 9 by 13 by 2-inch pan.

For the crust:

Sift together the flour and powdered sugar, add the margarine and mix till well combined. Press the mixture into the prepared pan. You may need to dip your fingers into a little flour or confectioners' sugar to keep the dough from sticking to your fingers. Bake the crust for 15 to 20 minutes, until very lightly browned. Allow crust to cool.

For the filling:

Beat the egg whites separately to stiff peak, when beater is turned upside down the egg white peak will stand stiff. Set aside. Beat by hand or with electric mixer the sifted flour, sugar, egg yolks, lemon juice and lemon peel together. Then fold in egg whites with a rubber spatula. Pour filling over cooled crust and bake for 20 minutes, until the filling is set. Let cool to room temperature.

Cut into 20 squares to make 40 triangles and dust with powdered sugar.
