The weekend is here, filled with life and specialness!

**LUAU, SUNDAY, 4 PM**: The highlight is of course the LUAU this Sunday afternoon. The doors will open at 3:00 pm in the Fellowship Hall, the dinner at 4:00 pm, and the show at 5:00 pm.
