PASTOR: Garden Grove was given a blessing we have been praying and hoping and working for, for a long timeour Conference administrators this week approved GGSDA appointing a Search Committee to look for a Youth/Young Adult pastor! The Church Board will be meeting at 8:00 pm Monday night to appoint a representative search committee, that will certainly include young people themselves, and their leadership. I will meet with Conference leadership early in January to go over all the available names they are aware of, and then Pastor Sandy Roberts will be meeting with our committee until a decision is made! They would like to have a name to present to the Executive Committee by the end of January, so that is just terrific news. Some of the details and protocols will still be negotiated, and some of that will depend on our continuing to grow in our Tithe Base. But they are all hearing great things about our church, and we give thanks to God for the blessing He has poured out on our church this year. If you have the name of someone you want the committee to consider, feel free to pass it on to me, and when the committee begins to meet formally with the Conference we will add them to The List!

At 10:40 am, the YAM singers will lead carols as we all process down to the Church Sanctuary, where Lisa Bethen and the Worship Committee have planned another highlight Christmas Sabbath, with music, Children's Story, the next Advent Candle.

The MESSAGE/HOMILY will be: "IMMANUEL--The God Who Is Always Coming."

The text is: Matt. 1:22 "All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet: 'The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and they will call him IMMANUEL--which means "God with us.""

But the story comes from 1 Samuel 4, where they took the Ark of the Covenant into battle with them, hoping that that would mean God would be with them and give them a great victory.

Questions for your family to discuss:

- What was so wrong about taking the Ark into battle with them?
- Should the Ark have always been left in the Most Holy Place, where only one high priest could see it, or should it be taken out into the real world, where everyone could see it, and God could use His power to bless everybody who saw it and touched it?
- If you were God, would you stay invisible, or would you be more obvious than God is now?

YEAR-END GIVING: The Church has been blessed with everybody who gives faithfully to the Tithe (10%), and to Church Budget, where we need at least 3% from everybody to give our church a chance to be excellent in all that it does, to the glory of God. We have already passed the \$400,000 mark for Tithe, and we are just amazed and blessed. We have just about cleared our entire Tuition Aid commitment of over \$20,000, and I am just very, very proud of our church, we poured thousands into evangelism, and it has just been a great year. Our membership has gone from 1028 to over 1150. Almost every week we have a baptism or Professions of Faith.

But we also humbly ask you to also focus on Church Budget for this year. We have done well all year long, but not as well as with Tithe! The Tithe goes to the Conference, and pays for the pastors, part of the teachers' salaries, and to support the work of the Conference and the church around the world. But it is Church Budget that does all that Garden Grove SDA is trying to do.

It looks, as of this minute: (1) We need about \$6000 to make Budget for December; (2) We will need about \$19,000 to make up for losses where we have had to go into a deficit to repair the church after the flood and to deal with deferred maintenance that just could not be put off any longer.

And so we need \$25,000 between now and the end of the year to finish up well, and start 2011 ready to take the church to the next level. No one person can carry much of that. But if everybody is absolutely faithful and stretches and puts God and the church first on their list, we can have this church firing on all cylinders, excellent in all that it does, and then we can focus on truly doing some new and creative ministries into our community this next year, more evangelism, getting onto the media, etc.

Just remember that everything for 2010: Tithe, Church Budget, Thailand, everything else, needs to be in or postmarked by midnight, December 31!
