**ORANGEWOOD WORKBEE**: Our group of pastors have made a deal with Orangewood Academy to have a 4-hour Sunday morning work-bee to help get projects done all over the campus.

January 30, Sunday, 8-12. We will have snacks, and then the Home and School will provide lunch at noon. We need skilled, and those not so skilled! I'll be there, it's just going to be a fun time, and it is a way to give back to Orangewood without having to use more money! Here are at least some of the projects they would like to do that day, but there will be something that fits everybody: Projects

- 1. Paint stairs on gym going up to middle school = 6 people
- 2. Clean weeds and brush behind the shop and throw away junk = 4 people
- 3. Paint six yellow middle school doors green = 2 people
- 4. Cut down tree by elementary flagpole = 3 people
- 5. Clean area by the well (trim low branches, rake up leaves and weeds) = 5 people
- 6. Take out rotted fence, swing set, and stump between house and pre-school =  $\overline{3}$  people
- 7. Help put up chicken wire above shop doors = 4 people
- 8. Tar paper and install siding on small section above elementary hallway = 4 people
- 9. Cement work (small areas here and there) = 2 people
