Pastor's Newsletter July 8, 2011

Yes, we're back! We got home early this morning, after just over 2 weeks in Thailand with our group of 78. Some came back early, 3 or 4 are still traveling, but 61 of us came back last night together. We thank God for a terrific and safe trip and hope that all we tried to do helped build the Kingdom of God over there. But the blessing was mostly on us!

THAILAND: We will give some of our report tomorrow at church, but the heart and soul of it all will be on July 16, giving us some time to get our pictures and all of it together. But the essence of the trip is:

- 1. We helped finish two faculty houses--paint, cement, landscaping, and paid for the third, that had a professional crew doing the actual building.
- 2. We did a Week of Prayer and held evangelistic meetings at the Chiangmai Adventist Academy.
- 3. We held 5 other sets of evangelistic meetings in various locations. A total of 30 have already been baptized, and others in each church took their stand for further studies and baptism in the future.
- 4. We did medical clinics and started building SS rooms at each of those locations.
- 5. We taught English classes, Leadership classes, and held a Vacation Bible School at the school.
- 6. We were able to fund quite a long list of needs, from the school, local churches, the orphanage, and a local Adventist Media Center that has been started, and several from our group took on further commitments.

The construction work had its usual challenges, with rain, heat, and just plain hard work, carrying buckets of sand and gravel, leveling clay mud in the rain, etc. etc.! But everybody jumped in and just did whatever it took to get it done, and I don't think we could have gotten more out of the situation than we did--the athletes would say, "We left it all on the court!" We finished with 2 and a half days at the beach just south of Bangkok for a spiritual retreat, and it was something every single one of us needed after the intensity of working physically all day and holding meetings at night. We want to thank the entire church and every donor who helped our young people get over--they were just terrific in carrying the load of the construction, music, drama--all of it.
