PATHFINDERS: It's not too late to register for Pathfinders and Adventurers. There will be a table in the foyer after church tomorrow where you can turn in your forms or fill one out. Tomorrow, August 27, will be the last day! If you won't be at church tomorrow, please email me your address, and the number of applications you will need, and I will be happy to send them to you. The final deadline to turn them in is on September 3. Our meeting times will be from 1:30 pm to 3:30 pm on the first and third Sabbath of each month, unless otherwise indicated on our calendar of activities. We will meet in the Pathfinder room and lunch will be provided in the Fellowship Hall on non-potluck days prior to each meeting. Our kick-off meeting will be September 3, 2011, in the Pathfinder room. The registration fee is \$100 for your first child and \$75 for your additional children and may be divided into payments. If you pay the entire fee up front, we will give you a 10% discount. We can also work with you if financial constraints make it difficult for you to take advantage of one of our payment options. The fee goes towards uniform shirts, patches, work books, craft supplies, outings, camping supplies, and lunch. What a deal at about \$10 per month for the Pathfinder/Adventurer year! We will make a huge effort with some pretty simple fundraisers that will help with the cost of outings as well. Your leaders are unpaid volunteers committed to making a difference in the lives of the Orange County community youth! Please give your children an opportunity to grow into responsible adults in these Christ-centered youth organizations!
