what we believe

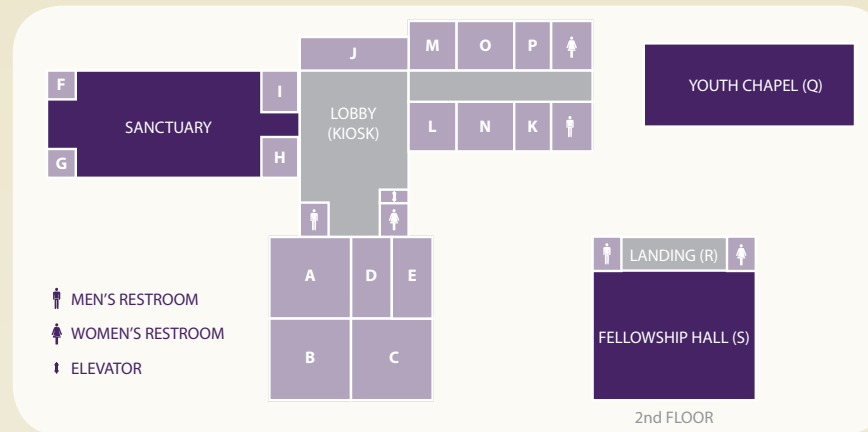
