### what we believe

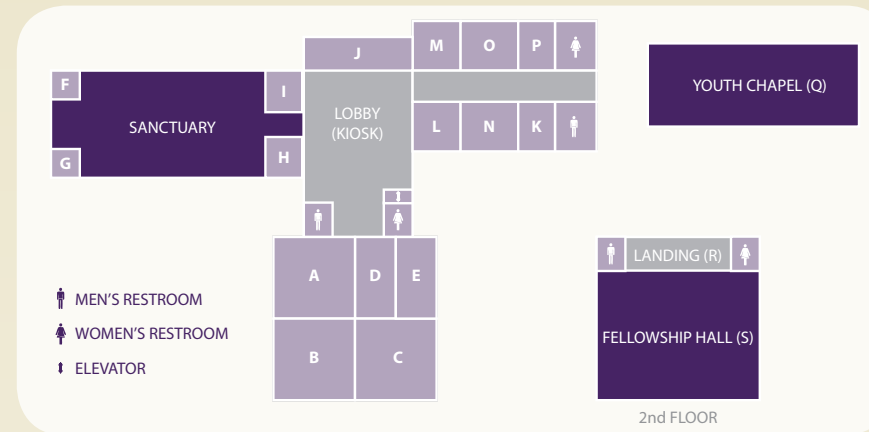
