Dear GGSDA Saints!

December is half gone—but the party really begins now—everybody has finished test week at school, the school programs are done—now you can enjoy the last of your gift-giving, Christmas food, families coming in, get up into the mountains for some skiing/snowboarding—at least that's what we're hoping!

CHRISTMAS EVE SABBATH: We are making next Sabbath a truly "Big Day," and asking that you try to invite at least one person to come! Every family that brings one person to come, will receive a special wrapped gift from our church, my brother's brand-new book, **Parables**, from Pacific Press, AND the guest they bring will also get a wrapped copy! Covenant Singers will be singing the highlight magnificent Christmas choruses, and a few of the classic solos—they have even asked me to do one, for the first time in 37 years! There will be brass, and the Choir will also be accompanied by a quartet from the LA Philharmonic! No Adventist Church in all of southern California is going to be have better music than GGSDA!

CHRISTMAS DAY: Dinner, 11 am to 12:30 pm. A group of GGSDA members are absolutely passionate that no one in our church or in our nearby community eat alone on Christmas Day. YEAREND GIVING: Obviously this is the time of the year when the Church stretches out to make sure that our facilities and ministries are all funded 100%, so that we can start out 2012 ready to do all the ministries we will talk about below. All we can ask is that if GGSDA has blessed you this year, and God has been good to you—do your best to be faithful back to God—a full tithe of 10%, and offerings as God has blessed you. We need between 3-5% for Church Budget from everybody who is also paying tithe, and we can pay for all that we have tried to do to advance our ministries this year. We have poured thousands into getting the Youth Chapel upgraded to match the enthusiasm Pastor Garrett has brought. We are in the middle of doing the same for Pastor Shiphrah and the Young Adults. We just bought 4 \$1000 heaters for the SS rooms. We have had to bring nuclear winter to the termites, over \$15,000! We are trying desperately to bring our facility into total excellence for the glory of God, so that then we can focus everything on ministry to the community, evangelism, our terrific school, and our young people. Everything has to be postmarked by midnight December 31. Thanks, and may God replenish every dollar you give to Him!
