WELCOME TO GARDEN GROVE! It is a BIG DAY here today! We will not only have a great worship service, but also the HERITAGE SINGERS CONCERT TONIGHT! We will begin studying 40 Days of Purpose the week of February 4 through 11. what we believe

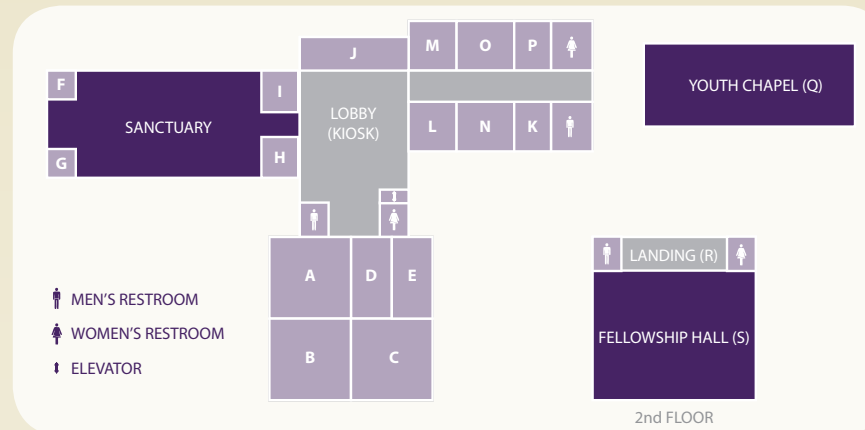
