what we believe

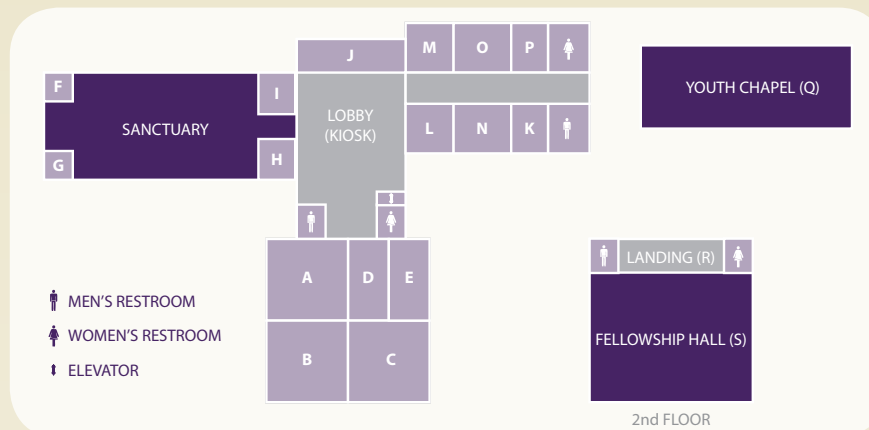
