## My Friends!

I have just received an email from the pastor that I worked the most closely with in the Philippines--he has five churches in his district, and my church was his main church. We have been asking for a list of all those who were baptized at the prison and at the pool from his district the last afternoon--and he sent it! 334 precious names! We will pray over them tomorrow. Quite a few of them made it to church that first Sabbath, in spite of heavy rains, and the Church Board met in emergency session to figure out ways to get more of them to church! So I hope all of our efforts towards helping them stay in church are paying off. We left them money to buy chairs for them, money to buy a small laptop so they could project the songs on the screen because nobody has hymnals, we left them 3 motorcycles for the 3 pastors(they had to contribute a portion of it), and Bibles for each of the new members. Jesus died for every one of them, and we refuse to lose a single one!

**Sound System Update:** The Campaign is heading into the homestretch. We have \$45,600 in cash and pledges so far, towards the \$75,000 we need to get the matching donation and complete the entire campaign. We are ready to order the whole sound system package the minute we see the final pledge! Even if your part might seem minor in terms of the whole--that's how the Church does everything we do--aggregating all the littles into something that does huge things for God. If you haven't made a pledge yet, it would be a great blessing if you would fill one out tomorrow, for whatever God whispers to you to put--and God will bless you for it!
