Have you ever given someone else--what *they* were praying for?! Just a few questions to get you into the Christmas/Advent spirit tonight!

THE WAY is tonight, 7 pm. Always full, always full of life and truth dialed in right at HS youth. It's not too late to get in the car and drive your young people down!

SANCTUARY (9:30): The Church is all decorated, ready for Advent! Pastor Shiphrah leads off into a new series, "THE SUNDERING"--it's a powerful idea, but I'll let her reveal the secret behind the title when you hear her message. A great band, stand and worship God, a drama that is right-on--and then the message.

SABBATH SCHOOL (10:30): Great SS in every room of the Church, one that will fit you and everybody! If not sure where to go, come try mine! Pastor's Bible Class, in the Pathfinder Room, studying the Three Angels' Message of Revelation 14 right now, between 45 and 50 coming every week now, we'd love to have you in our newly upgraded room!
