What were the three objects lost, then found?

Answer: The lost son, the lost coin, the lost sheep (Luke 15)

Does God ever change his mind?

Answer: No, God is the same yesterday, today and forever. (Malachi 3:6, Hebrews 13:8)

Was the Sabbath for the Jews?

Answer: No, it was given to the first created beings (Genesis 2:1-2).

What word does God use when giving the command for the Sabbath?

Answer: Remember. It is almost as if God knew that his children would forget the Sabbath, so he started the commandment with the word: "Remember" (Exodus 20:8).

How do we know that Saturday is the Sabbath?

Answer: Jesus died on Good Friday, which was the preparation day. He rested on the Sabbath and he rose on Easter Sunday (Luke 23:54-56 & Luke 24:1).

What day did Jesus go to church?

Answer: Saturday (The Sabbath Luke 4:16).

Does Jesus speak about the Sabbath regarding the end of time?

Answer: Jesus says: "Pray that your travel be not on the Sabbath" regarding persecution many years after he died and resurrected (Matthew 24:20).

How do we know that Jesus didn't come to destroy the law?

Answer: Jesus came to fulfill the law (Matthew 5:17-18).

What does sin do to our relationship with God?

Answer: Separates (Isaiah 59:2).

Sin separates us from:

1. God
2. Our family
3. Society

Since we are separated what did God do to reconcile us?

Answer: Sent his Son to become sin for us (II Corinthians 5:21)

How much does Grace cost?

Answer: Everything to God, nothing to man (Ephesians 2:8-9)

What are the Steps to Salvation?

A- Acept that you are a sinner THEN **Ask** for forgiveness
For all have sinned and fallen short (Romans 3:23).

B- Believe in Jesus and you will be saved THEN **Be** thankful for the gift of
grace
Believe in Jesus and you are saved (Acts 16:31).

C- Confess your Sins THEN **Claim** the promise
If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us and cleanse us
(1 John 1:9).

D- Decide to live for Jesus today THEN **Do** his commandments
Behold I stand at the door and knock, and if any man hear my voice and
open I will come in to him (Revelation 3:20).

E- Experience the joy of baptism THEN receive **Eternal** life
Except a man be born of water and the Spirit he cannot enter the
kingdom of God (John 3:5)

Why get baptized?

Answer: We get to experience the death and resurrection of Christ (Romans 6:3-4)

Why did Christ get baptized?

Answer: For our example (Matthew 3:15-17)

Is rebaptism Biblical?

Answer Yes, there are three specific reasons when re-baptism is helpful:

1. Committed horrific open sins such as murder, adultery,
2. Left the church lived a heathen life and want to come back through rebaptism
3. Never understood why you got baptized in the first place
