What will I be judged for?

Answer: Everything, including the secret things (Ecclesiastes 12:14).

Where does judgment happen?

Answer: In heaven (Daniel 7:9,10).

When Daniel 7:9-10 says: "the judgment was set and the books are opened" what are the names of these books?

Answer: The Book of Life (Revelation 20:12) and the Book of Remembrance (Malachi 3:16).

Will both the dead and the living be judged?

Answer: Yes (1 Peter 4:5).

Has God appointed a specific day to judge the world?

Answer: Yes (Acts 17:31).

Where in heaven does Christ intercede on our behalf?

Answer: The heavenly sanctuary (Hebrews 9:24)

Is there a heavenly sanctuary?

Answer: Yes (Psalms 102:19)

When does the judgment take place?

Answer: Daniel 7 tells us where the judgment takes place. Daniel 8 tells us when. The judgment started in the year 1844. The Bible says in Daniel 8:14 "Unto 2300 days then shall the sanctuary be cleansed" The start date was the command to rebuilt and restore the temple in 457 BC, if you add 2300 years it will take you to the year 1844.

Note: In Bible Prophecy 1 day needs to be changed to 1 year according to Numbers 14:34 and Ezekiel 4:6

Why does the Bible say that the gospel was given to the Jew first then to the Greek?

Does it mean that God loves the Jews more than he loves the Greeks?

Answer: No, God does not love one people Group more than another. However, God does choose certain people to be His chosen vessel to share the Gospel to the world. According to Romans 1:16 the Jews were first given the Gospel, then after they rejected Jesus he chose the Greeks or Gentiles to share the message to the entire world.

Where in the Bible do I have the assurance that the judge is also my defense attorney?

Answer: God is not only the Judge, the King, the Lawgiver but he is also our defense attorney and his number one goal is to save us! Isaiah 33:22
