Dear Friends--

For some of you this is your first newsletter from us--because either you just started coming because of our UNCOVERED meetings with Pastor Michael, OR you were baptized this last Sabbath! What an incredible day that was, to see 11 baptized! Saturday night you could just feel the "buzz" in the room, as we came to the last night of being together almost every night for 2 weeks, with terrific food, great praise music (we will all miss singing "Worthy Is the Lamb" every night)--and just tremendous, powerful, God-anointed preaching. Pastor Michael and Candice are visiting all of the other sites that are holding UNCOVERED meetings this week (Mentone, Beaumont, Hemet, etc.), and then will be flying to the Big Island of Hawaii next week to start another series almost exactly like ours! Here are the main events of this weekend:

THE WAY: Tonight, 7:00pm, Youth Chapel: Here is Pastor Garrett's announcement: "TONIGHT we start our brand new series at The Way - What's Your Story? Hope you'll join us as Cambria kicks off our series and shares her stories and struggles and walk with Christ! Have you ever been ashamed of the things you've done? LEGACY: Those of you with a long history in the church remember **Elder Morris Venden.** He pastored most of the large Adventist churches in the US, and spoke for hundreds of weeks of prayers and campmeetings around the world over his ministry of 50 years. He had a huge impact, really revolutionary, on bringing the gospel and righteousness by faith to the church, starting a great revival on campuses in the early '70s. He passed away recently, the memorial service is Sunday, at the Loma Linda University Church. The pastoral staff of GGSDA and the Worship Committee decided to dedicate the sermons for the month of March in both services to highlighting some of the great themes he championed as we honor his Legacy.

This Sabbath, then, I will speak in both services on the one sermon that I heard Morris preach several times, and he told me that if he had only one sermon to preach to encapsulate his whole lifetime message, it would be this one: "THE MAN WHO WENT NAKED TO THE WEDDING!" from Matthew 22.

So SANCTUARY, 9:30am, and DIVINE WORSHIP, 11:30am.

AND--at least one more will be baptized, with others scheduled for virtually every week throughout March!

PASTOR'S BIBLE CLASS: 10:30am, Pathfinder Room. Our class for all seekers and those anxious to study and discuss at a cuttingedge level meets in between the two worship services. Tomorrow is on the "**Close of Probation and Revelation 15**". All of a sudden it says the heavenly sanctuary is empty and filled with smoke. So where does Jesus go? Does that mean that there will be a time when there is no more grace and forgiveness? How can we know when that time will be? Is it an arbitrary time set by God, or how is the time set?

POTLUCK: This is our monthly potluck, so come, welcome our new members, and keep the buzz going that's been in the Fellowship Hall for the last two weeks!
