Please pray for us all, 77, as we pack and get on a plane Sunday night. We will meet at Orangewood at 6:45 if you want to come send us off, be part of a wonderful tradition of hugs and prayer as we go.

OFFERING: We announced last week that we will take a second offering tomorrow for Tonga. It will go for the evangelism and construction projects. We budgeted \$4000 for this offering, but we really need about \$7000 to restore where we had to borrow from those projects to pay for the crates, for customs and duties, and other disasters! We don't want any of your faithful tithe and offerings, that will all go in the first offering. We are hoping that everybody could do \$20 per person, others will do more as they are able, and somehow we will go with enough to at least do many of the items on their list from the churches and the Mission there. This is their one chance to get some help for a very isolated mission, and we would love to be able to help as much as possible.

We will have a lovely candlelit processional and dedication tomorrow, so I think it will be a great service at DIVINE WORSHIP (11:30). We have a baptism, a beautiful young Vietnamese woman who has studied with Pastor David. The message will be: "AN ACTS 2 CHURCH!"
