VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL: 6-8:30 pm, Fellowship Hall. Helen Tovar and their team have done a terrific job, with over 50 kids there virtually every night, high energy, great programs, crafts, dinner every night, etc. Make sure to give each leader you see a heartfelt thanks and high-five!

SMALL GROUPS: Great small groups training session at the Fullerton Church, 2355 W. Valencia Drive, Fullerton. 6-8 pm. Don James has been teaching and been the champion for small groups in the Adventist Church and at the Seminary for over 20 years, and we are very excited to go to this weekend. 2-6 pm Sabbath afternoon, and again Sunday morning.

SABBATH SERVICES: Pastor Garrett will speak at both services, preaching on Elijah and Elisha: "**STRIKE THE WATER!"** Our main farewell will be during Divine Worship at 11:30 am. The statistics are pretty clear, the difference between those who stay in the church and those who don't, between those who went to Christian education and didn't--the ratio is about 80% to 50%. And the statistics are also clear, that children in SDA schools do about 1/2 a grade to 1 whole grade better academically than those in public schools. So the blessings are there, and we want to be there to help when we can!
