November 8, 2013

Dear GGSDA Saints!

First, above all, don't forget: This is one of our biggest Sabbaths of the year, with the GARY BONNER SINGERS coming from Riverside. They are always fantastic, and we expect the church to be full. A great worship service to invite somebody to.

Second, I wish you could feel the buzz that is flowing through the offices of GGSDA as we go into a higher gear with the newly voted 3-year Master Plan. The Board has voted it, but we are looking for a time to invite the entire church to discuss it, revise it, and eventually add their approval to it. David Kharns is giving us three months as our Operations Director, trying to help us get this fantastic Master Plan off paper and into full operational reality!

- 1. A great new Small Groups initiative will be announced tomorrow and there will be a booth in the Lobby.
- 2. We signed a contract with a great Church Management system, that will help us keep track of all our groups and so, so much more, and everybody is updating their lists to upload this week. Over 250 young adult names. 50-60 Vietnamese. Youth. Filipino. Our Visitor/Interest file.
- 3. Church Facilities discussed and voted on at least 20 separate items this week, as we work constantly to make our church facilities excellent at every level.
- 4. Grace University--Our team dedicated to mission and outreach, giving Bible studies will meet Tuesday night this week, 7:30 pm, and Paula Hollmon has agreed to be our Administrator!
- 5. Our Vietnamese Fellowship meets every week with between 50-60 now, with 18-20 in SS at 3 o'clock. Just amazing. The Filipino Fellowship is following suit with their own worship in the afternoon at 2:30, AFTER they have already worshipped us in the English service, and had 40 in their first service!
- 6. Elder Gerald Penick came down to meet with us, checked out his new office, and will begin to move things in and get settled, even though he will not begin officially until January.
- 7. In 2 weeks we will have our final interview for Young Adult Pastor, and we hope that by Nov. 25 a decision will have been made, and then we will pray that God will impress the right one to accept our call!
