welcome message from pastor dan



TODAY we want to worship in solidarity with our Adventist brothers and sisters in the Philippines whose lives have been completely disrupted by the typhoon. We have between 30 and 40 Filipinos in our own church, but many thousands in our Southeastern and Southern California Conferences, many of whom have family

in these decimated areas. We pray for them today, and we will also give you a chance to contribute to their relief if you can. We have already sent \$8,500 in water, food, medicine, and building materials, which was taken within minutes directly to the coast and delivered to the most needy of our brethren in that location and their neighbors. We have also sent \$1,500 to begin rebuilding a destroyed school in northern Palawan, and hope we will be able to send the remaining \$3,500 they need to complete the school this week. We know many of you cannot afford to give much, and please do not divert your tithes and church budget offerings. However, if you can afford even \$20, \$50, or \$100 to help, it will be a blessing to our Filipino friends and family. A lot of us giving, a little quickly adds up to another truck of water and food being sent to the children who are suffering on the coast. If it was us, we would be praying for our brothers and sisters elsewhere to help—so helping is exercising the Golden Rule in the clearest way!

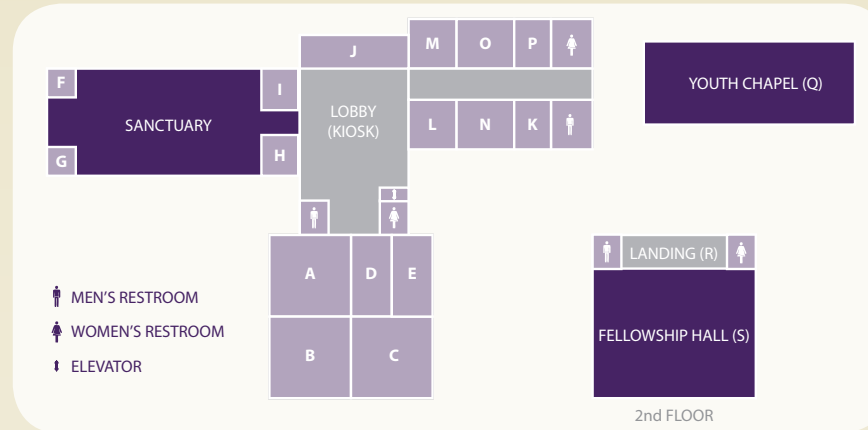
