## Metals



- Metals are strong and are useful for making tools, buildings, bridges and other structures where strength is important.
- Most metals are hard.
- Many metals are sonorous or make a bell-like sound when struck.
- Noble metals like silver, gold and platinum, resist corrosion and oxidation in moist air.
- The word 'metal' comes from the Greek word 'metallon,' which means to mine, excavate or extract from the ground.
- The metals are subdivided into separate groups, such as basic metals, transition metals, alkali metals, alkaline earth metals, rare earth, lanthanides and actinides.
- At room temperature, all of the metals are solids except for mercury, which is a liquid.
- Most common metal found in the Earth's crust is aluminum.
- Many metals are heavy or dense, although some metals, such as lithium, are light enough to float on water!
- Metals are elastic or tend to bend rather than break.
- Alkali metals, such as lithium, sodium, potassium, and rubidium, are so reactive they will ignite and even explode if placed in water.





### Watermelon



- The first recorded watermelon harvest occurred nearly 5,000 years ago in Egypt.
- It was depicted in Egyptian hieroglyphics on walls of their ancient buildings.
- Watermelons were often placed in the burial tombs of kings.
- Watermelon is 92% water.
- Watermelon's official name is Citrullus Lanatus of the botanical family Curcurbitaceae. It is cousins to cucumbers, pumpkins and squash.
- By weight, watermelon is the most-consumed melon in the U.S., followed by cantaloupe and honeydew.
- Early explorers used watermelons as canteens.
- The United States currently ranks 5th in worldwide production of watermelon.
