welcome message from pastor dan



MABUHAY! Thank you for choosing to be with us at GGSDA today, and we are very happy that you are with us!

DEDICATION: We have 58 volunteers leaving this coming week on a mission trip to General Santos, on the island of Mindanao in the Philippines. It is nearly the southernmost city in the Philippines, quite close to Indonesia. We will be holding meetings at 16 sites every night and doing Vacation Bible Schools at five of those

sites. During the daytime, we are doing a number of church and school construction/remodeling projects as well as providing medical and dental care clinics. Everyone going on the trip have not only either paid from their own funds or raised approximately \$2,500 to go but are also using precious vacation time to go, so high five them today and bless them. We will try to blog from there, so that the entire church family can feel that they are part of the mission. Those of you who have bought a ticket to a fund-raiser concert or slipped some money into somebody's fund certainly have a right to feel that you are right there serving God yourself!

If you have some Mission funds you can spare, we will be taking a second offering at the end of the worship service. We really, really need about \$3,000 in order to meet what the Mission has asked GGSDA to contribute towards the 16 crusades we are holding. The money goes to pay for laymen who go out and visit all day in the villages, studying the Bible, serenading their interests, and bringing the youth and interests on the buses to the meetings every night. It also goes for transportation, that they call jeepneys. In the Philippines, every dollar has a huge impact . . . the more buses we can put out, the more people will come, make a decision, and be in heaven forever with us someday! So please do whatever you can to help us have the needed funds. You cannot leverage your money any better than this!

CONCERT: We have a special choir group from the Philippines with us today, for both the worship service and the concerts tonight. They are from our school in Illigan City—the same island where we will be going—which has 1,800 students taking nursing, pharmacy, physical therapy, and other allied health science courses. They will sing for worship today, and then put on a sacred concert tonight at 6:30 and a secular concert/show with Filipino songs and cultural dances at 8:15. The concerts are all free with some light snacks in between. There will be an offering taken at each concert to help the chorale pay its expenses.

BAPTISM: A young lady, Jennifer Savin, who has basically grown up around our church, has made the decision to be baptized this Sabbath! She has been at GGSDA with her best friend Clarisse Bonang virtually every Sabbath for the last five years. A beautiful young lady, Jennifer is a full member of our Drama Team, and has also decided to go to Orangewood Academy this fall after graduating from 8th grade this year. Love her and celebrate with her this morning!


