Jesus died for her, and she heard something over the last two weeks, she was around the group, and made her decision! Wow.

SAVE THE DATE: "HE'S THE ONE" Weekend--August 1-2. For all of you who have ever seen the bumper sticker, "After Religion, Try Jesus"--this is for you. If you've ever thought or said--"I love Jesus, but I'm not sure about the Church"--this is for you.
