PHILIPPINES REPORT:

Having stayed up late a couple nights putting all of our Philippines Projects together:

MUCH THANKS TO Quiet Hour Ministries, HELP Foundation, and many private anonymous donors who made this all happen, and of course the 58 who went, and those who supported them.

Approx. 1100 baptisms for our 16 sites; 1550 we were a part of that Sabbath. 2400 from all over the Mission that day, and 9000 from January to July 12 as part of our overall Crusade season.

Projects:

Constructing or upgrading 29 churches

Schools: Internet Room, 3 computers, Water tank for a college, benches for their chapel, and two classrooms.

If all the pledges come in from various donors and Foundations from around the country all come in, the overall infusion into that Mission is over \$99,000.

Praise God. Now pray that the pastors and lay Bible workers and church members do everything they can to nurture these precious new people, and to finish the projects they started while we were there!
