THE HAZEL PROJECT:

Many of us are banding together to send over some support to Hazel Alvarenga, one of our terrific young adults, helped so much getting the First Service started--who is teaching first grade as a student missionary on the island of Yap until the end of May. Over the next week we hope to raise some money to pay for one month's tuition for all 11 of her students. We also want to send over school supplies, toys, library books, whatever else we can do that would be a blessing to her and those kids. We will show a video in both services tomorrow.

The goal is \$671 for the 11 students' tuition, or \$61 per student if you want to scholarship one child. Mark the envelope: **"THE HAZEL PROJECT"** and give it by March 14

Here is a list of what else they could use. Either give money for it or bring it to the Concierge Desk by Sabbath, March 14:

- 1. BOOKS--beginning level reading books (new, used, anything)--buy at consignment stores
- 2. SCHOOL SUPPLIES--wide-ruled notebooks, wide-ruled filler paper, pencils, big pink erasers, folders, color pencils, crayons, markers, index cards, pencil pouches, watercoler paint, watercolor pencils, modeling clay, construction paper
- 3. BIBLE-RELATED ITEMS: Children's Bibles, card games, Bible stories, puzzles, coloring books
- 4. PRIZES: Small candy (Jolly Ranchers and Iollipops), small toys, puzzles, card games, coloring books, bubble bottles, action figures, puppets, toy cars, planes, beach balls, water balloons, prizes from kids' meals.
