To all of you with a connection to GGSDA / OC GRACE!

STOP. Just, please, stop. That's what God is saying, right now! "Could you just please stop—whatever you're doing—and look at Me?" "You've been in your world all week—can you just switch over—now—to MY World? Just look away from those other screens, and look at Mine. I'll make it worth it to you! I'll bless you. But I can't bless you—if you don't—just—stop!"

As the Sabbath slides across our time zone, the Sabbath comes to your house, it flows all around you—and He quietly whispers and knocks. And He says, "If anyone hears My Voice, and opens the door, I will come in, and eat with you and you with Me." Listen for it!

THE WAY.—The weekend starts, as it always does, with THE WAY. Our long-lost Pastor is back from speaking in Ireland, and she will be there tonight at 7 pm, ready with Heidi-food and worship and a message and hang-out time. Get your young people in the car and bring them down! The kids in Ireland had to go to a camp and sleep in tents in the cold to hear her! This is easy.

TUITION AID: As long as we're talking about young people—tomorrow is our BIG offering for Tuition Aid. Orangewood Academy is doing so many good things—many rooms were painted, some great new teachers—now it's up to us to get our kids there. We have over 20 who will need our help to make it. Parents are putting in \$400 to \$700 a month themselves to do this. We are that last bridge to make it possible. If you can save something after the main tithes and offerings--\$20 a person, \$50, \$100, or at least make a pledge for the rest of the year—we would be thrilled.

There is no cause, no building, no mission project—you can put your money into—that will make more of a difference long-term than helping kids get a Christian education. The statistics are crystal clear—a much higher percentage stay with God and the Church, AND do better academically!

TITHES AND CHURCH BUDGET: We also ask you this—If God has been faithful to you—one of the best ways to honor Him back is to be faithful back to Him. Don't give to help the Church pay its "bills"—do it to honor God, to give thanks to Him. For grace, for life, for family, for prayer, for heaven, for whispering wisdom all day every day.

Tithe, 10%, you know. What not everybody knows is—The Tithe doesn't stay at Garden Grove and help with our ministries and facilities. That all comes through Church Budget. Our core members are all giving 10% Tithe and something around 3-5% for Church Budget. That takes care of our Sabbath Schools, youth, Young Adult, music ministries, Orangewood Academy, our office, all of it.

The Budget Committee met this week, and revised the budget for 2015, and we have a Budget to present to the Board this week. There were cuts that hurt, but our best and most important ministries were all kept. If you can just join our group and stand shoulder to shoulder with us to help take GGSDA / OC GRACE to the next level, we would be very, very thankful!
