Colon Community Urban Ministry Seminar, 7:30 tonight, Fellowship Hall

We are just 3 hours away from the beginning of a weekend that we believe can be a landmark moment in the history of our church. We are already a great church, in many ways. We have 4 worship services every week., that over 500 people come to. We have programs and ministries happening all the time—people who visit us are shocked at all that is going on. Hundreds have gone on at least one mission trip somewhere on the other side of the world. We have people getting baptized in the church or in the ocean every 2 or 3 weeks.

BUT many of us have felt that, still, something was missing. There is a gap. The gap was and is our own local community. Is God wishing we would do more—for them? Would they miss us if we sold and moved away? Are there people living without something that God meant for us to be the ones to give it to them? He started the Urban Ministry program at one of our SDA colleges, that Sara-May herself took and graduated from. They hold seminars on this all over the world. They have been missionaries in Africa and Russia. Pastor Sara has started coffee shops and been involved in social justice programs for years, and longs to see GGSDA / OC GRACE step up and get our hands dirty in our community, much more than we have.
