THIS SABBATH:

OC GRACE FIRST: I believe that Pastor Tony is wrapping up the great "Jesus Uncensored" series today at our contemporary service at 9:30 this morning.

SECOND SERVICE: We start a great new series on the book "**STEPS TO CHRIST**". It is one of the most published books in the history of the world. Every paragraph is rich, and it is difficult to not just underline every line. We are fulfilling a New Year's Resolution, to get more spiritual, to get closer to God, and to know Jesus better, in a very personal way. There are 13 chapters, so 13 Sabbaths, so the series will run for every Sabbath from January to March, ending with Easter March 27. We have also prepared a lovely new video clip on the Love of God we hope will draw hearts to Him this first Sabbath of the New Year.

FELLOWSHIP DINNER: You are invited to join us upstairs for a New Year's Fellowship Dinner right after Church.

VIETNAMESE FELLOWSHIP: 4:30 pm, in the Youth Chapel. Congratulations go to this Fellowship, which is often from 35-50 people, who raised over \$10,000 for their new church project in Vietnam. Another donor matched that donation for a total of \$20,000, and those checks went out yesterday. That church is already up and we have seen pictures of the congregation of over 800 already meeting in there even while waiting to get it all finished. Our mission trip for March, 2017, is to hold 4 nights of evangelistic meetings in that church, and it is just a thrilling project!

BASKETBALL COURT BRICKS: We believe we are very close to having our budget completed for the basketball court, and the engineer has been instructed to confirm the plans with the city, get the permit for the lights, so we can begin.
