It's a big weekend for our church in several ways:

- 1. **VIETNAMESE EVANGELISM.** Tonight and tomorrow night, 6:30 pm dinner, 7:30 meeting, there will be evangelism for our Vietnamese Fellowship upstairs in the Fellowship Hall. There will be a wonderful dinner each night at 6:30. The sermons will be in English, translated to Vietnamese, so if any of you would like to come support us we would love to have you come and pray for us and cheer the Fellowship on. They have worked very hard to decorate and prepare music and give Bible studies and ESL classes, and we hope God will send some people hungry to have more God in their lives.
- 2. **PASTOR GERALD:** This pastor has a very risky but very exciting ministry to Muslims, largely in Iran. He will give a report during church, preach, and share some great piano special music. After potluck, he will share a seminar on how to minister to Muslim's. It has been very well received every year, and we hope you will plan to stay for this program.

It will be next **Sabbath, May 21**. We desperately need at least \$3000 in that offering--from all of our worship services. If you can bring a \$20 bill from the ATM it will help us tremendously. One donor who has helped us a lot over the years had a down year and just could not help us at all. So we are going very, very thin. We are holding 17 crusades, VBS in almost every site, 3 major building projects, many medical and dental clinics, and giving 17 sets of cut felts, one to each church. We know most of you can't go—but with your \$20 you will be there having a part in it!
