HACKSAW RIDGE: A group of us were invited to see an early screening of a new movie that will be coming out November 4. It is a mainstream release but they are certainly hoping that the faith community will come out to see it. It is the story of **Desmond Doss**, a Seventh-day Adventist, who still is the only conscientious objector to have ever won a Congressional Medal of Honor for bravery and courage under fire, for saving 75 men by lowering them over the Ridge while under fire. It is directed by Mel Gibson, so there are his usual fairly violent but very realistic scenes from the terrible fighting on this Ridge. But the parts where his heroism were shown were simply fantastic. Everybody will have to make their own decision on whether they want to see it, see the reviews, etc. They have tried to keep the language clean, and it is very clear that he was an Adventist, going to church, reading the Bible, and taking a stand for his beliefs about using a gun in war. We were all asked to fill out s survey, and evidently they have made some changes already based on the reactions of the faith focus groups. It will be interesting to see what the reaction will be when it is released across the country.
