Tonight is the opening of the movie, **HACKSAW RIDGE**. It is a great, great story about an Adventist, Desmond Doss, a true hero who lowered 75 men down the Maeda Escarpment in Okinawa during WW II and was the first conscientious objector to receive the Medal of Honor. A few of us had the chance to preview the movie. It's a great, incredible story, but before you go understand that it is filled with the violence of war, and be sure that you have all your spiritual filters up to not let all that contaminate your soul, like Daniel and the lions thousands of years ago! ! We will respect everybody who decides not to go, and those who decide to go. The Church and a few donors will be buying 2000 copies of the missionary, book, **Hero of Hacksaw Ridge**, that Remnant Publications, an Adventist publisher, is putting out. We hope to have them for you next Sabbath, for you to read, and a few copies to give to anyone who you talk with about it. We hope to send 1000 out with the Pathfinders during their food drive for Thanksgiving. It is a few of the best chapters from the original book, **The Unlikeliest Hero**, by Herndon, along with 30 pages by Doug Batchelor explaining "the faith of the man," sharing the Adventist beliefs that made Doss take his stand. If anyone would like to buy more, they are \$.99 each.
