Pastor Toan flies over there this next week, and will be helping firm up all the plans.

Pastor Tony is speaking for First Service, in their new ACTS Series, we continue in Second Service on Promises, looking at the fantastic promise to people who give tithes and offerings--The windows of heaven will open and pour out a blessing, so much that you cannot receive it.
