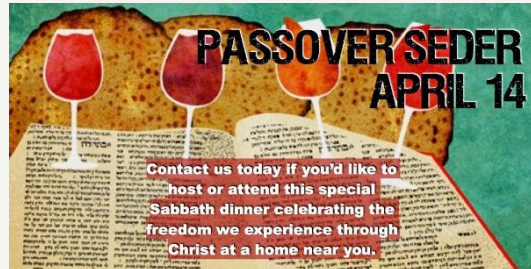
Kids who died because they got bombed with chemical weapons?

All of that is part of it. But there are also those things: Six felt sets for the Philippines got done, one went with Pastor Ed Tuesday.

We ordered 77 water filters, and someone paid for two 50,000-gallon water tanks so that those church members on those two islands where Pastor Ed started those two churches can have clean water year round! And he flew on a small plane and is back on those islands this minute for Sabbath morning services!

The money came in to finish 7 churches that will be dedicated over there by the first of May. Someone from 100 miles away heard about the church in Vietnam that needed SS rooms for 300 kids and cement around the church for parking and sidewalks, and is bringing a check on Easter to pay for all of it. The same night we lost our doctor for the mission trip, another called and said he was in between positions and had the time to go.

Our video ministry found somebody to handle all of the creative screens and introductions and closings. Somebody else stepped in to cover a gap in the church budget we just couldn't solve. I bumped into a man I have tried to lead to Jesus for 20 years in Rite Aid this afternoon, and he asked me if I believed in witchcraft, thinking that he might be cursed, and for maybe the first time he seemed soft and open to the Gospel that he needed Jesus.

So how was your week?! It's always a mix, of good stories and craziness, saints and evil people--until The Coming.
