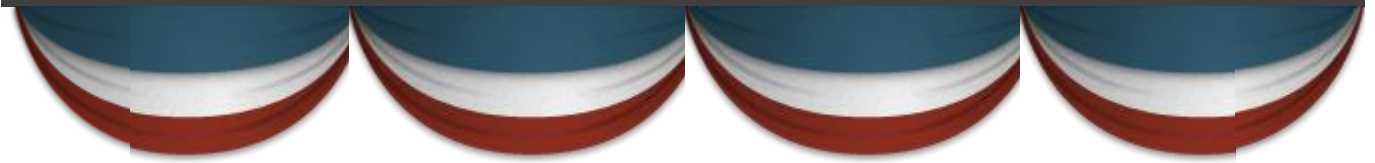

The only route into the GGSDA Church Neighborhood will be from Garden Grove Boulevard.

CLOSURES! (STAY AWAY FROM THESE ROUTES):

- 1) Chapman Ave. - From West Street to Nutwood Street
- 2) Euclid Street - From Orangewood Ave. to Garden Grove Blvd.
- 3) Ninth Street - From Orangewood to Lampson
- 4) Lampson Ave - From Ninth Street to Nelson Street

Below are the directions recommended by the Police Sergeant in charge of the day's traffic.

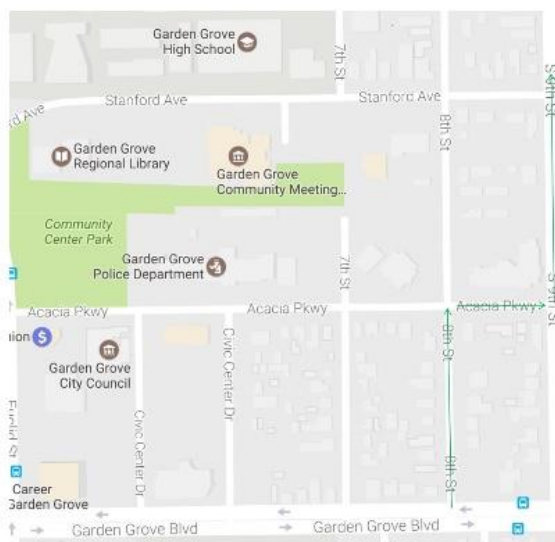
If you are coming from North or West of the church, use Katella to Harbor, then Harbor to Garden Grove Blvd, OR use the 22 freeway and exit Euclid.

Directions from Harbor / Garden Grove Blvd:

- Right on Garden Grove Blvd (From Harbor)
- Right on 8th Street (1 street past 9th Street)
- Right on Acacia
- Left on 9th Street

Directions from the 22 Freeway and Euclid:

- North on Euclid
- Right on Garden Grove Blvd
- Left on 8th Street
- Right on Acacia
- Left on 9th Street

A quick update on the summer BRAZIL Mission Trip with Pastor Sara! The list has come together this week at a solid 26, just enough for one boat load going down the Amazon and doing these great projects in the villages along the river--August 3-16. The cost is \$2100, with \$650 what we pay ADRA for each person for the boat, food, and all the mission project supplies. Most of the group are finding ways to fund their trip, but we have about ten who really could use their church's support.

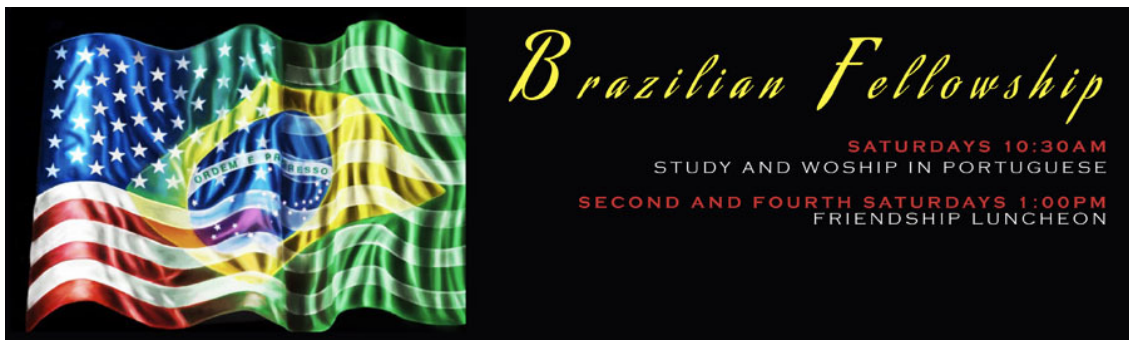
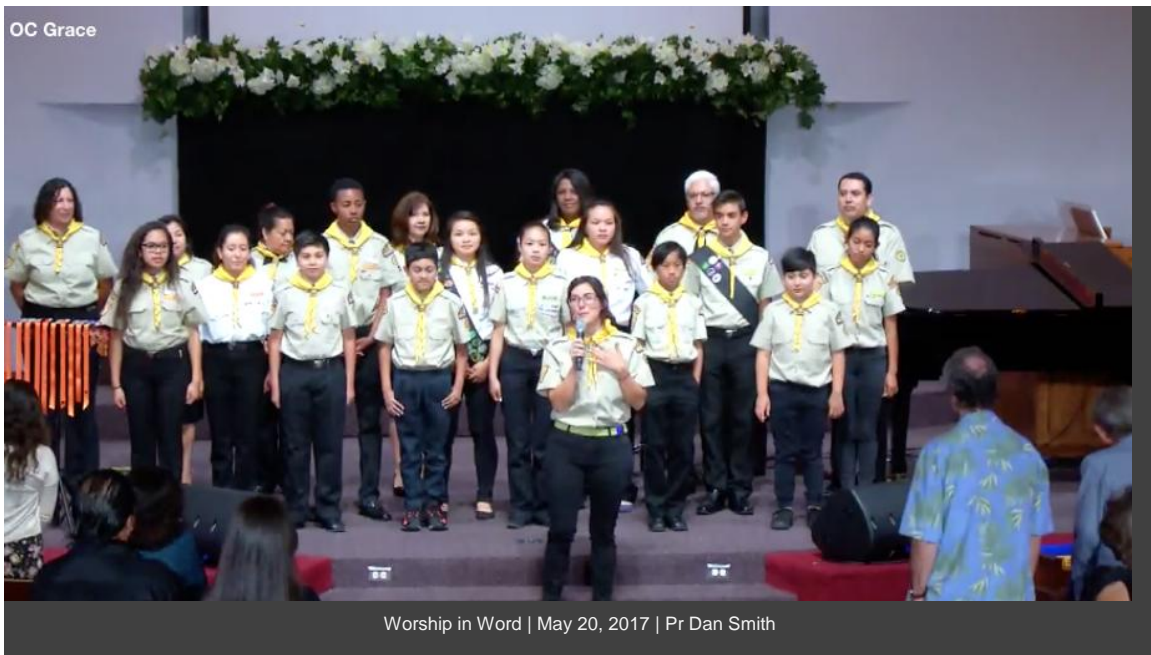
9:25am SERVICE [Fellowship Hall]
