Arla Caraboolad, LMFT,CFLE

Arla Caraboolad, EMPT, CPLE

Timothy R. Jennings, M.D., is a board-certified Christian psychiatrist, master psychopharmacologist, international speaker, a Distinguished Fellow of the American Psychiatric Association, and Fellow of the Southern Psychiatric Association. An author of five books, Dr. Jennings is in private practice in Chattanooga, Tennessee. and is President and Founder of Come and Reason Ministries He has also served as President of the Southern Psychiatric Association and Tennessee

Psychiatric Association.



Herb Montgomery, director of Renewed Heart Ministries, is an author and adult religious reeducator. For over fifteen years, Herb and his wife, Crystal, have shared Jesus' teachings with others in cities and communities across the United States. Herb has an unusual gift for making complex theological and sociological concepts accessible for the people to whom he speaks.



Jon Paulien, Ph.D. is Professor of Religion and Dean of the School of Religion at Loma Linda University. Author of more than twenty-five books and more than two hundred articles and other publications, Dr. Paulien is a specialist in the study of the Johannine literature in the New Testament (the Gospel of John and Book of Revelation) and the intersection of faith

with contemporary culture.



Jean Sheldon, Ph.D. is Professor of Old Testament at Pacific Union College. For her Ph.D., she specialized in comparing the Hebrew Bible with ancient Mesopotamian texts, a study she has continued since.



Alden Thompson, Ph.D. is a professor emeritus in the Theology Department of Walla Walla University in Washington, but who continues to teach there. He got his doctorate in Edinburgh, and has contributed many books, and was a regular columnist for Signs of the Times and other church periodicals throughout his career. His major contribution was the book "INSPIRATION," which has become a classic in understanding inspiration and become a classic in understanding


inspiration and hermeneutics. His series "From Sinai to Golgotha" in the Adventist Review in 1982 was a seminal series about how God takes people in stages in their understanding of Him and truth.



Dr. John Webster, Ph.D., is originally from South Africa, and taught for many years at Helderberg College there. But he has been teaching theology and philosophy at La Sierra University in Riverside, and was the Dean of the HMS Richards School of Divinity until recently.
